RE: Revision of FCBDD Behavioral Support Routing Slip and Human Rights Committee (HRC) Review Minutes

The FCBDD Routing Slip and Human Rights Committee (HRC) Review Minutes have been revised. The HRC Review Minutes now has only six items and the language of the Minutes is taken directly from the Behavioral Support Rule OAC 5123:2-2-06 (F) (3) (a-f).

The Routing Slip is now the Routing Form and includes a requirement for teams to discuss the same six questions that are asked by HRC.

EFFECTIVE October 1, 2019: PRIOR TO sending a packet to FCBDD Psychology Department for review of recommended restrictive measures, a team must discuss the six HRC questions and insure that all Rule requirements are met. One member of the team (likely the behavioral specialist or service coordinator) should complete both pages of the Routing Form and send it with the packet to FCBDD Psychology Department.
