Vaccine Clinics Scheduled at FCBDD's Northeast Center

The Franklin County Public Health Department will conduct vaccine clinics in February in partnership with the Franklin County Board of Developmental Disabilities and ARC Industries at Northeast Center, 500 N. Hamilton Road, Gahanna. Free COVID vaccines will be given to members of the community.

The vaccine clinics are open to the public and will be held on February 10, 11, 24 and 25 from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. Those who receive their first dose will receive a \$100 gift card as long as supplies last. Vaccines will be available for anyone age 5 and older.
