Free Test Kits Ahead of Spring Gatherings

Free COVID-19 home test kits will be handed out to Franklin County residents Thursday, April 6 from 2-6 p.m. in the front loop of **Columbus Public Health**, 240 Parsons Ave., while supplies last.

Participants are limited to two tests per person/eight tests per vehicle. Free naloxone and fentanyl test strips also will be available.

Residents are encouraged to test for COVID-19 if they feel sick, especially as they make plans for spring gatherings that may include at-risk loved ones.

The most effective way to prevent serious illness and death from COVID-19 is to stay up-to-date on COVID-19 vaccines and booster doses. Visit www.Columbus.gov/c19vax for a list of all free walk-in clinic times.
